



Botanical Name: Asystasia travancoria syn salicifolia **Common Name:** Asystasia

Origin: Thailand, China, India, Laos

and Myanmar

Height/Width: 50-100 cm tall Habit: Shrubby perennial

Flower: Flowers are blue to purple held aloft on spikes and bell shaped

with darker throats

Leaves: Long narrow, pointed, shiny foliage draping to the ground (useful

in hanging pots).

Climate: Tropical/Sub-tropical

Soil: Well drained soil

Aspect. Sunny to part shade location.

Thrives in humid conditions

Prune: Light trim after flowering late

winter.

Drought/Frost: Tolerant/Tender **Propagation:** From cuttings taken

after pruning.
