



Botanical name: Ageratum

houstonianum

Common name: Blue Billy Goat Weed, ageratum, blue mink,

flossflower, goatweed.

Family: Asteraceae

Origin: Mexico, Central America and

the Caribbean

Height: 0.3m to 1 m

Habit: Annual or biennial herbaceous

plant

Leaves: Borne on stalks 0.5-3cm long and vary from being almost triangular in shape to egg shaped broader at the base. Leaves are 2-7cm x 1.5-6cm and bluntly toothed. Leaves are softly haired (pubescent).

Stem: The stems are rounded, green

and pubescent

Flower: Terminal flower heads arranged in dense clusters and do not have obvious petals. Each flower-head has numerous tiny tubualar flowers surrounded by greenish coloured bracts. The florets range from pale lavender, pink or

Seed: Reproduces mainly by seed that are dispersed by wind, water or animals, clothing and vehicles. The 'seeds' are about 2 mm long, brown to black in colour, and topped with five awn-tipped scales. These scales are whitish in colour and resemble short bristles or hairs.

Habitat & Environmental Impacts:

An environmental weed in Qld and NSW that has invaded bushland and other natural environments resulting in substantial changes in native plant communities, displacing indigenous plants and native animals. It is particularly invasive along waterways and in riparian vegetation

Toxicity: It contains pyrrolizidine alkaloids so can affect the liver if consumed by herbivores.

Control: Foliar spray using an appropriate herbicide or manual removal.
